- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 26.504(a) and (b), Water Code, are

- 8 (a) The <u>commission shall</u> [operator of a concentrated animal
- 9 feeding operation shall contract with a person described by Section
- 10 26.503(b)(2)(E)(ii) selected by the executive director to] collect
- 11 one or more representative composite soil samples from each waste
- 12 application field <u>associated with a permitted concentrated animal</u>
- 13 <u>feeding operation</u>. The <u>commission</u> [<del>operator</del>] shall <u>perform the</u>
- $[\frac{\text{have}}{\text{o}}]$  sampling  $[\frac{\text{performed}}{\text{o}}]$  under this subsection not less often
- 15 than once every 12 months. <u>Sampling results obtained by the</u>
- 16 commission shall be used by the permitted concentrated animal
- 17 <u>feeding operator to satisfy any annual sampling of waste</u>
- 18 application fields required by commission rule or individual
- 19 permit.
- 20 (b) Each sample collected under this section must be tested
- 21 for phosphorus and any other nutrient designated by the <a href="commission">commission</a>
- 22 [executive director]. [The test results must be made available to
- 23 the executive director and the operator of the concentrated animal

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
