6	SECTION 1. Chapter 234, Local Government Code, is amended
7	by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:

10	Sec. 234.051. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
11	(1) "Day-care center" has the meaning assigned by

14	Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
15	Sec. 234.052. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
16	to a county with a population of 700,000 or more.
17	Sec. 234.053. COUNTY MAY REQUIRE CERTIFICATE. The
18	commissioners court of a county by order may require a day-care
19	center or group day-care home located in an unincorporated area of
20	the county to obtain a health and sanitation certificate from the
21	county.
22	Sec. 234.054. FACILITY INSPECTION FOR CERTIFICATE ISSUED BY
23	COUNTY. (a) A county health officer or official designated by the

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commissioners court may conduct an inspection of a day-care center

- 3 (b) The county may charge a fee to a day-care center or group
- 4 day-care home for an inspection conducted under this section in an
- 5 amount determined by the commissioners court to cover the cost of

1 Sec. 234.073. FACILITY INSPECTION REQUIRED ВҮ 2 MUNICIPALITY. A county health officer or official designated by the commissioners court may contract with a municipality for the 3 4 county to conduct an inspection required by the municipality of a day-care center or group day-care home located in the municipality. 5 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009. 10
