Sec. 234.053. FACILITY INSPECTION REQUIRED BY

MUNICIPALITY. A county health officer or official designated by 1-23 1-24 the commissioners court may contract with a municipality for the 1-26 1 - 27county to conduct an inspection required by the municipality of a day-care center or group day-care home located in the municipality.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-28 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-30 1-31 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
