S.B. No. 897

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to certain reporting requirements in connection with the 3 transportation of hazardous materials by a railroad company. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1(1), Chapter 350 (S.B. 1101), Acts of 5 the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989 (Article 6419c, 6 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows: 7 "Department" ["Commission"] means the 8 (1)Texas Department of Transportation [Railroad Commission of Texas]. 9 SECTION 2. Sections 2(a) and (b), Chapter 350 (S.B. 1101), 10 Acts of the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989 (Article 6419c, 11 12 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), are amended to read as follows: 13 (a) A railroad company that transports hazardous materials 14 in or through the state shall file with the department [commission] a copy of each hazardous materials incident report that the company 15 16 files with the federal Department of Transportation in accordance with 49 C.F.R. 171.16, not later than the 15th day after the date 17 18 that the incident that forms the basis of the report is discovered. Not later than April 1 of each year, a railroad company 19 (b) that transports hazardous materials in or through the state shall 20 provide to the <u>department</u> [commission]: 21 22 (1) a map depicting the location of each railroad main 23 line and branch line that the company owns, leases, or operates in 24 the state;

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1 (2) a map delineating the geographical limits of the 2 railroad company operating divisions or districts and the principal 3 operating officer for the railroad company in each operating 4 division or district;

5 (3) a primary and secondary telephone number for the 6 railroad company dispatcher responsible for train operations in 7 each operating division or district;

8 (4) a list of each type of hazardous material by hazard 9 class and the quantity of the material transported over each 10 railroad line owned, leased, or operated by the railroad company 11 during the preceding year; and

12 (5) the name and address of the railroad company 13 employee in charge of training persons to handle an incident 14 related to hazardous materials.

15 SECTION 3. Section 3, Chapter 350 (S.B. 1101), Acts of the 16 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989 (Article 6419c, Vernon's 17 Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3. (a) The <u>department</u> [commission] shall compile information submitted to the <u>department</u> [commission] under this Act for distribution to:

21 (1) local emergency management agencies located in 22 jurisdictions containing reported railroad operations; and

23 (2) the metropolitan planning organizations for those
24 jurisdictions.

(b) At least once each year the division of emergency management shall distribute the information compiled by the department [commission] to the appropriate officials for inclusion

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1 in local emergency management plans.

2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
