4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2171.055, Government Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsection (j) to read as follows:

7 (j) An officer or employee of a hospital district created

8 under general or special law who is engaged in official hospital

district business may participate in the commission's contract for

10 travel services for the purpose of obtaining reduced airline fares

11 and reduced travel agent fees. The commission may charge a

12 participating hospital district a fee not to exceed the costs

13 <u>incurred by the commission in providing services under this</u>

subsection. The commission shall periodically review fees and

15 shall adjust them as needed to ensure recovery of costs incurred in

16 providing services to hospital districts under this subsection.

17 The commission shall deposit the fees collected under this

18 subsection to the credit of the hospital district airline fares

19 <u>account.</u> The hospital district airline fares account is an account

20 in the general revenue fund that may be appropriated only for the

21 purposes of this chapter. The commission shall adopt rules and make

22 or amend contracts as necessary to administer this subsection.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
