- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 707, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 707.0021 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 707.0021. IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTY ON OWNER OF
- 9 AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLE. (a) In this section, "authorized
- 10 <u>emergency vehicle" has the meaning assigned by Section 541.201.</u>
- 11 (b) A local authority may not impose or attempt to impose a
- 12 civil penalty under this chapter on the owner of an authorized
- 13 <u>emergency vehicle.</u>
- 14 <u>(c) This section does not prohibit an employer from taking</u>
- 15 disciplinary action against an employee who as the operator of an
- 16 authorized emergency vehicle operated the vehicle in violation of a
- 17 rule or policy of the employer.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
