- 1 (b) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally,
- 2 knowingly, or recklessly, by act or omission, causes or encourages
- 3 a child to participate in any criminal activity that is:
- 4 (1) committed by a criminal street gang; and
- 5 (2) punishable as a Class A misdemeanor or a felony.
- 6 (c) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 7 degree if the offense is committed intentionally or knowingly. An
- 8 offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor if the offense
- 9 is committed recklessly.
- 10 (d) If conduct, including an omission, constituting an
- 11 offense under this section also constitutes an offense under
- 12 another section of this code, the actor may be prosecuted under
- 13 either section or under both sections.
- 14 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 18 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 19 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 20 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 21 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
