## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to erecting an off-premise sign adjacent to and visible 2 from certain roads that follow the route of El Camino Real de Tierra 3 Δ Adentro. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 391.252, Transportation 6 Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 8 (a) A person may not erect an off-premise sign that is adjacent to and visible from: 9 (1) U.S. Highway 290 between the western city limits 10 of the city of Austin and the eastern city limits of the city of 11 12 Fredericksburg; State Highway 317 between the northern city limits 13 (2) 14 of the city of Belton to the southern city limits of the city of 15 Valley Mills; State Highway 16 between the northern city limits (3) 16 of the city of Kerrville and Interstate Highway 20; 17 (4) U.S. Highway 77 between State Highway 186 and 18 State Highway 44; 19 20 (5) U.S. Highway 281 between: 21 (A) State Highway 186 and Interstate Highway 37, 22 exclusive of the segment of U.S. Highway 281 located in the city limits of Three Rivers; and 23 (B) the southern boundary line of Comal County 24

1 (17) Farm-to-Market Road 2978 between Farm-to-Market 2 Road 1488 and the boundary line between Harris and Montgomery Counties; 3 4 (18)U.S. Highway 90 between the western city limits of the city of San Antonio and the eastern city limits of the city of 5 Hondo; [<del>or</del>] 6 7 (19) the following highways in Austin County: (A) State Highway 159; 8 9 (B) Farm-to-Market Road 331; 10 (C) Farm-to-Market Road 529; Farm-to-Market Road 1094; and 11 (D) Farm-to-Market Road 2502; or 12 (E) 13 (20) the following highway segments that are a part of the route of El Camino Real de Tierra Adentro: 14 15 (A) Farm-to-Market Road 258 between 16 Farm-to-Market Road 1110 and Loop 375; and 17 (B) State Highway 20 between State Highway 260 18 and the border of this state and the state of New Mexico. SECTION 2. The change in law made by Subsection (a), Section 19 20 391.252, Transportation Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an off-premise sign erected on or after the effective date of 21 this Act. An off-premise sign erected before the effective date of 22 this Act is covered by the law in effect when the sign was erected, 23 24 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
