5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Title 99, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by
7	adding Chapter 2003 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 2003. ADVERTISING STANDARDS FOR SALE OF PROPERTY LOCATED
9	IN SUBDIVISION
10	Sec. 2003.001. ADVERTISING STANDARDS BEFORE SALE:
11	DISCLOSURE OF HIGHWAY PROJECTS. Brochures, publications, and
12	advertising of any form relating to subdivided land must indicate
13	the location of each highway project that:
14	(1) is contained in:
15	(A) the Texas Department of Transportation's
16	unified transportation program;
17	(B) the Texas Department of Transportation's
18	statewide transportation improvement program; or
19	(C) an official planning document of a local
20	transportation entity, including a regional mobility authority,
21	regional tollway authority, or county toll road authority; and
22	(2) is identified in the planning document as going
23	through or running adjacent to the subdivision.
24	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 212, Local Government

- 2 Sec. 212.0102. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT: DISCLOSURE OF
- 3 HIGHWAY PROJECTS. The municipal authority responsible for
- 4 approving plats by ordinance shall require the plat application to
- 5 have attached to it a description and map of each highway project
- 6 that:
- 7 <u>(1) is contained in:</u>
- 8 (A) the Texas Department of Transportation's
- 9 unified transportation program;
- 10 (B) the Texas Department of Transportation's
- 11 statewide transportation improvement program; or
- 12 (C) an official planning document of a local
- 13 transportation entity, including a regional mobility authority,
- 14 regional tollway authority, or county toll road authority; and
- 15 (2) is identified in the planning document as going
- 16 through or running adjacent to the subdivision.
- 17 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 232, Local Government
- 18 Code, is amended by adding Section 232.0034 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 232.0034. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT: DISCLOSURE OF
- 20 HIGHWAY PROJECTS. The commissioners court of a county by order
- 21 shall require a plat application to have attached to it a
- 22 description and map of each highway project that:
- 23 (1) is contained in:
- 24 (A) the Texas Department of Transportation's
- 25 unified transportation program;
- 26 (B) the Texas Department of Transportation's
- 27 statewide transportation improvement program; or

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- 1 (C) an official planning document of a local
- 2 transportation entity, including a regional mobility authority,
- 3 regional tollway authority, or county toll road authority; and
- 4 (2) is identified in the planning document as going
- 5 through or running adjacent to the subdivision.
