## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to a length exemption for a vehicle or combination of 2 3 vehicles used to transport a combine used in farm custom harvesting 4 operations. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 622.902, Transportation Code, is amended 7 to read as follows: Sec. 622.902. LENGTH EXCEPTIONS. 8 The length limitations provided by Sections 621.203 to 621.205 do not apply to: 9 10 (1)machinery used exclusively for drilling water wells, including machinery that is itself a unit or that is a unit 11 12 mounted on a conventional vehicle or chassis; 13 (2) a vehicle owned or operated by a public, private, 14 or volunteer fire department; 15 (3) a vehicle or combination of vehicles operated exclusively in the territory of a municipality or to a combination 16 17 of vehicles operated by a municipality in a suburb adjoining the municipality in which the municipality has been using the equipment 18 or similar equipment in connection with an established service to 19 the suburb; 20 a truck-tractor, truck-tractor combination, 21 (4) or 22 truck-trailer combination exclusively transporting machinery, materials, and equipment used in the construction, operation, and 23

maintenance of facilities, including pipelines, that are used for

1 the discovery, production, and processing of natural gas or 2 petroleum;

3 (5) a drive-away saddlemount vehicle transporter 4 combination or a drive-away saddlemount with fullmount vehicle 5 transporter combination, as defined by 23 C.F.R. Part 658 or its 6 successor, if:

7 (A) the overall length of the combination is not8 longer than 97 feet; and

9 (B) the combination does not have more than three 10 saddlemounted vehicles if the combination does not include more 11 than one fullmount vehicle;

12 (6) the combination of a tow truck and another vehicle13 or vehicle combination if:

(A) the other vehicle or vehicle combination
cannot be normally or safely driven or was abandoned on a highway;
and

(B) the tow truck is towing the other vehicle or
vehicle combination directly to the nearest authorized place of
repair, terminal, or destination of unloading; or

20 (7) a vehicle or combination of vehicles used to 21 transport a combine that is used in farm custom harvesting 22 operations on a farm if the overall length of the vehicle or 23 combination is not longer than:

24 <u>(A)</u> 75 feet <u>if the vehicle is traveling on a</u> 25 <u>highway that is part of the national system of interstate and</u> 26 <u>defense highways or the federal aid primary highway system; or</u>

27 (B) 81-1/2 feet if the vehicle is not traveling

3	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
