## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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| 2  | relating to the development of a climate adaptation plan by certain |
| 3  | entities.   |
| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:             |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Health and Safety Code, is          |
| 6  | amended by adding Chapter 393 to read as follows:                   |
| 7  | CHAPTER 393. CLIMATE ADAPTATION PLAN                                |
| 8  | Sec. 393.001. PARTICIPATING ENTITIES. Not later than                |
| 9  | September 1 of each even-numbered year, each of the following       |
| 10 | entities shall publish a climate adaptation plan that will assess   |
| 11 | the entity's role with respect to climate change:                   |
| 12 | (1) the Department of Agriculture;                                  |
| 13 | (2) the independent organization certified under                    |
| 14 | Section 39.151, Utilities Code;                                     |
| 15 | (3) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;                  |
| 16 | (4) the General Land Office;  |
| 17 | (5) the Health and Human Services Commission;                       |
| 18 | (6) the Texas Department of Housing and Community                   |
| 19 | Affairs;  |
| 20 | (7) the Texas Department of Insurance;                              |
| 21 | (8) the Parks and Wildlife Department;                              |
| 22 | (9) the Department of Public Safety of the State of                 |
| 23 | Texas;  |
| 24 | (10) the Public Utility Commission of Texas;                        |
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| 1  | (11) the office of the comptroller;                                 |
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| 2  | (12) the Texas Department of Transportation;                        |
| 3  | (13) the Texas Forest Service; and                                  |
| 4  | (14) the Texas Water Development Board.                             |
| 5  | Sec. 393.002. PLAN. (a) Each climate adaptation plan must           |
| 6  | <pre>include:</pre>   |
| 7  | (1) a climate change vulnerability assessment;                      |
| 8  | (2) a review of existing programs in the context of                 |
| 9  | anticipated changing climate conditions;                            |
| 10 | (3) specific steps necessary for the entity to fulfill              |
| 11 | its mission during the anticipated climate change;                  |
| 12 | (4) an analysis of the effects implementing the steps               |
| 13 | identified under Subdivision (3) would have on the entity's budget  |
| 14 | during the next 2, 5, and 10 years;                                 |
| 15 | (5) potential sources of funding to support the                     |
| 16 | entity's efforts to adapt to climate change; and                    |
| 17 | (6) a statewide strategy to monitor the continuing                  |
| 18 | effects of climate change.  |
| 19 | (b) In developing a climate adaptation plan, each entity            |
| 20 | <pre>subject to this section shall:</pre>                           |
| 21 | (1) consider the most current assessment report                     |
| 22 | created by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change; and       |
| 23 | (2) consult with at least one institution of higher                 |
| 24 | education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code.            |
| 25 | (c) Not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year,          |
| 26 | each entity subject to this section shall post the entity's climate |
| 27 | adaptation plan on a publicly accessible Internet website and       |

- 1 electronically submit a copy of the plan to:
- 2 (1) the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of
- 3 the house of representatives;
- 4 (2) the presiding officer of each standing committee
- 5 or subcommittee of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over
- 6 environmental matters; and
- 7 (3) the executive director of the Texas Commission on
- 8 Environmental Quality.
- 9 (d) Each climate adaptation plan is subject to audit by the
- 10 state auditor in accordance with Chapter 321, Government Code.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
