- 4 in relation to the evaluation that a state agency subject to review
- 5 under Chapter 325 would perform in relation to a review.
- 6 (c) Unless otherwise provided by the legislature by law, on 7 September 1, 2013 [2011]:
- 8 (1) the powers and duties transferred to the

- 10 Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, are
- 11 transferred to the Texas Facilities Commission;
