S.B. No. 1021

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a prohibition on parking a commercial motor vehicle in  
3 certain residential subdivisions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 545.307, Transportation Code, is amended  
6 by amending Subsections (b) and (b-1) to read as follows:

7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), after 10 p.m.  
8 and before 6 a.m., a person may not park a commercial motor vehicle  
9 or leave the vehicle parked:

10 (1) in a private driveway that is located in a  
11 residential subdivision; or

12 (2) on a street that is maintained by a county or  
13 municipality and for which signs are posted as provided by  
14 Subsection (c) if the street:

15 (A) [~~(1)~~] is located within a residential  
16 subdivision; or

17 (B) [~~(2)~~] is adjacent to a residential  
18 subdivision and within 1,000 feet of the property line of a  
19 residence, school, place of worship, or park.

20 (b-1) A person may park a commercial motor vehicle or leave  
21 the vehicle parked in a private driveway that is located in a  
22 residential subdivision, or on a street for which signs are posted  
23 as provided by Subsection (c) if the commercial motor vehicle:

24 (1) is transporting persons or property to or from the

1 residential subdivision or performing work in the  
2 subdivision; and

3 (2) remains parked in or adjacent to the subdivision  
4 only for the period necessary to complete the transportation or  
5 work.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
