## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a prohibition on parking a commercial motor vehicle in

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 545.307, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (b) and (b-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), after 10 p.m.
- 8 and before 6 a.m., a person may not park a commercial motor vehicle
- 9 or leave the vehicle parked:
- 10 (1) in a private driveway that is located in a
- 11 residential subdivision; or
- 12 <u>(2)</u> on a street that is maintained by a county or
- 13 municipality and for which signs are posted as provided by
- 14 Subsection (c) if the street:
- (A)  $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$  is located within a residential
- 16 subdivision; or
- (B)  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  is adjacent to a residential
- 18 subdivision and within 1,000 feet of the property line of a
- 19 residence, school, place of worship, or park.
- 20 (b-1) A person may park a commercial motor vehicle or leave
- 21 the vehicle parked in a private driveway that is located in a
- 22 <u>residential subdivision, or</u> on a street for which signs are posted
- 23 as provided by Subsection (c) if the commercial motor vehicle:
- 24 (1) is transporting persons or property to or from the

- 1 residential subdivision or performing work in the
- 2 subdivision; and
- 3 (2) remains parked in or adjacent to the subdivision
- 4 only for the period necessary to complete the transportation or
- 5 work.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
