1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to a prohibition on parking a commercial motor vehicle in
1-9 certain residential subdivisions.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 545.307, Transportation Code, is amended
1-12 by amending Subsections (b) and (b-1) to read as follows:

1-13 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), after 10 p.m.
1-14 and before 6 a.m., a person may not park a commercial motor vehicle
1-15 or leave the vehicle parked:

1-16 (1) in a private driveway that is located in a
1-17 residential subdivision; or

1-18 (2) on a street that is maintained by a county or
1-19 municipality and for which signs are posted as provided by
1-20 Subsection (c) if the street:

1-21 (A) [~~1~~] is located within a residential
1-22 subdivision; or

1-23 (B) [~~2~~] is adjacent to a residential
1-24 subdivision and within 1,000 feet of the property line of a
1-25 residence, school, place of worship, or park.

1-26 (b-1) A person may park a commercial motor vehicle or leave
1-27 the vehicle parked in a private driveway that is located in a
1-28 residential subdivision, or on a street for which signs are posted
1-29 as provided by Subsection (c) if the commercial motor vehicle:

1-30 (1) is transporting persons or property to or from the
1-31 residential subdivision or performing work in the subdivision; and

1-32 (2) remains parked in or adjacent to the subdivision
1-33 only for the period necessary to complete the transportation or
1-34 work.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
