8 (b). The Board of Directors shall hold regular meetings, the date thereof to be established in the District's bylaws or by 9 10 resolution. The President or any three members may call such 11 special meetings as may be necessary in the administration of the 12 District's business, provided that at least five days prior to the 13 meeting date, the Secretary shall have mailed notice thereof to the address which each member shall file with the Secretary. Notices of 14 15 special meetings may be waived in writing by any Director. Board of Directors or Board committees may hold meetings by 16 17 telephone conference call, by videoconference call, or through communications over the Internet, in accordance with procedures 18 provided by Subchapter F, Chapter 551, Government Code, 19 determined to be necessary or convenient by the President or any 20 three members. A closed meeting of the Board of Directors that is 21 22 authorized under Chapter 551, Government Code, may include officers and employees of constituent cities of the District. Each Director 23

shall receive a fee as provided by general law for each day devoted

- 1 to District business. Each Director is also entitled to
- 2 reimbursement for actual expenses incurred in carrying out District
- 3 business, including attending a Board meeting. Payment to a
- 4 Director for services performed and expenses incurred is subject to

- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
