- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 271.182, Local Government Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 9 (c) This subchapter applies to a municipally owned combined
- 10 electric, water, and wastewater utility situated in an economically
- 11 distressed area and located within 30 miles of the Lower Texas Gulf
- 12 Coast. For this subchapter, "combined" means that the utilities
- 13 <u>are managed and controlled by one board whose members are appointed</u>
- 14 by the governing body of the municipality and that the financing of
- 15 capital improvements is secured from the revenues of all three
- 16 utilities.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
