Sections 345.251(b) and (c), Finance Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) If a documentary fee is charged under this section the fee: 8 must be charged to cash buyers and credit buyers; 9 (1)may not exceed \$100 [\$50]; and 10 (2) must be disclosed on the retail installment 11 (3) contract as a separate itemized charge. 12 13 (c) A preliminary work sheet on which a sale price is 14 computed and that is shown to the retail buyer, an order from the buyer, or a retail installment contract must include in reasonable 15 proximity to the place on the document where the documentary fee is 16 disclosed: 17 (1) the amount of the fee; and 18 the following notice in type that is bold-faced, 19 (2) 20 capitalized, or underlined or otherwise conspicuously set out from 21 the surrounding written material: 22 "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING DOCUMENTS 23 AND PERFORMING SERVICES RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF A SALE. 24 А

1 DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED $\frac{100}{50}$ [$\frac{50}{50}$]. This notice is required 2 by LAW."

3 SECTION 2. Section 348.006(c), Finance Code, is amended to 4 read as follows:

5 (c) For a documentary fee to be included in the principal6 balance of a retail installment contract:

7 (1) the retail seller must charge the documentary fee8 to cash buyers and credit buyers;

9 (2) the documentary fee may not exceed <u>\$100</u> [\$50] for a 10 motor vehicle retail installment contract or a reasonable amount 11 agreed to by the retail seller and retail buyer for a heavy 12 commercial vehicle retail installment contract; and

13 (3) the buyer's order and the retail installment 14 contract must include:

15 (A) a statement of the amount of the documentary16 fee; and

17 (B) in reasonable proximity to the place in each where the amount of the documentary fee is disclosed, the following 18 notice in type that is bold-faced, capitalized, underlined, or 19 otherwise conspicuously set out from surrounding written material: 20 "A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT AN OFFICIAL FEE. A DOCUMENTARY FEE IS NOT 21 22 REQUIRED BY LAW, BUT MAY BE CHARGED TO BUYERS FOR HANDLING DOCUMENTS AND PERFORMING SERVICES RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF A SALE. 23 А 24 DOCUMENTARY FEE MAY NOT EXCEED \$100 [\$50] FOR A MOTOR VEHICLE 25 CONTRACT OR A REASONABLE AMOUNT AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES FOR A HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLE CONTRACT. THIS NOTICE IS REQUIRED BY LAW." 26

27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
