The governing body of a municipality in a county with a population of at least 128,000 but not more than $\underline{300,000}$ [$\underline{133,000}$] may abolish the municipality's perpetual trust fund for a

cemetery and use the fund, including both principal and interest, for permanent improvements to the cemetery.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
