## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to authorization for the Department of Aging and
- 3 Disability Services to conduct a desk review instead of an
- 4 inspection when issuing a license after a change in ownership of

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 142.009, Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended by amending Subsection (j) and adding Subsection (j-1) to
- 9 read as follows:
- (j) Except as provided by Subsections (j-1), (h), and (l),
- 11 an on-site survey must be conducted within 18 months after a survey
- 12 for an initial license. After that time, an on-site survey must be
- 13 conducted at least every 36 months.
- 14 (j-1) The department, in accordance with department rules,
- 15 may conduct a desk review instead of the initial survey required by
- 16 Subsection (j) if the license application is submitted due to a
- 17 <u>change in ownership of an agency under this chapter. The executive</u>
- 18 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission by rule
- 19 shall develop criteria for determining when the department may
- 20 conduct a desk review instead of an on-site survey.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 247.023, Health and Safety Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 23 (a-1) The department, in accordance with department rules,
- 24 may conduct a desk review instead of the inspection and

- 1 investigation required by Subsection (a) if the license application
- 2 is submitted due to a change in ownership of a facility under this
- 3 chapter. The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 4 Services Commission by rule shall develop criteria for determining
- 5 when the department may conduct a desk review instead of an
- 6 inspection and investigation.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 252.033, Health and Safety Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 9 <u>(a-1)</u> The department, in accordance with department rules,
- 10 may conduct a desk review instead of the on-site inspection and
- 11 investigation under Subsection (a) if the license application is
- 12 submitted due to a change in ownership of a facility under this
- 13 chapter. The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 14 Services Commission by rule shall develop criteria for determining
- 15 when the department may conduct a desk review instead of an on-site
- 16 <u>inspection and investigation</u>.
- 17 SECTION 4. Section 103.006, Human Resources Code, is
- 18 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 19 (a-1) The department, in accordance with department rules,
- 20 may conduct a desk review instead of the on-site inspection under
- 21 Subsection (a) if the license application is submitted due to a
- 22 change in ownership of the facility under this chapter. The
- 23 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 24 by rule shall develop criteria for determining when the department
- 25 may conduct a desk review instead of an on-site inspection.
- SECTION 5. (a) Not later than April 1, 2010, the executive
- 27 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall

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- 1 adopt the rules required under Subsection (j-1), Section 142.009,
- 2 Subsection (a-1), Section 247.023, and Subsection (a-1), Section
- 3 252.033, Health and Safety Code, and Subsection (a-1), Section
- 4 103.006, Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (j-1), Section 142.009,
- 6 Subsection (a-1), Section 247.023, and Subsection (a-1), Section
- 7 252.033, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, and
- 8 Subsection (a-1), Section 103.006, Human Resources Code, as added
- 9 by this Act, the Department of Aging and Disability Services may not
- 10 conduct a desk review instead of a survey, inspection, or
- 11 investigation for a license application submitted due to a change
- 12 in ownership of an agency or facility under those sections until May
- 13 1, 2010.
- 14 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
