	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to authorizing the Texas Board of Criminal Justice to sell
3	certain real property for municipal airport expansion.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 496.0021, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to read as follows:
7	(c) The board shall authorize the sale of land directly to a
8	municipality at fair market value without the requirement of a
9	sealed bid sale if:
10	(1) the municipality seeking to acquire the land
11	notifies the department in writing of the municipality's desire to
12	acquire the land for municipal airport expansion;
13	(2) the land is located next to an active runway of a
14	municipally owned airport;
15	(3) the municipality is acquiring the land to expand
16	municipal airport facilities; and
17	(4) the department primarily uses the land for guard
18	housing.
19	(d) After receiving the notice required by Subsection (c),
20	the board shall:
21	(1) obtain an appraisal of the land to be sold to the
22	<pre>municipality;</pre>
23	(2) request that the municipality provide the board
24	with an appraisal of the land to be sold;

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(3) determine whether a third appraisal by an 1 appraiser mutually selected by the department and municipality is 2 necessary to determine fair market value of the land to be sold; and 3 4 (4) finalize the sale of the land to the municipality 5 at fair market value within 18 months of receiving the written 6 notice under Subsection (c). (e) In determining the fair market value of land to be sold 7 under Subsection (c), the department shall consider the necessary 8 9 remediation that must be completed before the land can be used for

10 <u>airport expansion. If a third appraisal is required under</u> 11 <u>Subsection (d), the fair market value is considered to be the</u> 12 <u>average of the three appraisals required under this section minus</u> 13 <u>any remediation costs.</u>

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
