12	(2) "Livestock" has the meaning assigned by Section
13	1.003, Agriculture Code.
14	(3) "Peace officer" has the meaning assigned by
15	Section 1.07, Penal Code, or other state or federal law.
16	(b) A landowner is not liable for damages arising from an
17	incident or accident caused by livestock of the landowner due to an
18	act or omission of a firefighter or a peace officer who has entered
19	the landowner's property with or without the permission of the
20	landowner, regardless of whether the damage occurs on the
21	landowner's property.
22	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
23	to an act or omission of a firefighter or peace officer that occurs
24	on or after the effective date of this Act. An act or omission of a

1 firefighter or peace officer that occurred before the effective 2 date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the act or 3 omission occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for 4 that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
