- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 75, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 75.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 75.006. LIABILITY LIMITED FOR ACTIONS OF FIREFIGHTER
- 8 OR PEACE OFFICER. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Firefighter" means a member of a fire department
- 10 who performs a function listed in Section 419.021(3)(C), Government
- 11 Code.

- 12 (2) "Livestock" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 13 1.003, Agriculture Code.
- 14 (3) "Peace officer" has the meaning assigned by
- 15 Section 1.07, Penal Code, or other state or federal law.
- 16 (b) A landowner is not liable for damages arising from an
- 17 incident or accident caused by livestock of the landowner due to an
- 18 act or omission of a firefighter or a peace officer who has entered
- 19 the landowner's property with or without the permission of the
- 20 landowner, regardless of whether the damage occurs on the
- 21 <u>landowner's property.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an act or omission of a firefighter or peace officer that occurs
- 24 on or after the effective date of this Act. An act or omission of a

- 1 firefighter or peace officer that occurred before the effective
- 2 date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the act or
- 3 omission occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 4 that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
