A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a rescission period for annuity contracts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 7, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Chapter 1116 to read as follows: 5 CHAPTER 1116. REQUIRED PROVISIONS FOR ANNUITY CONTRACT 6 7 Sec. 1116.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "annuity" means a fixed, variable, or modified guaranteed annuity that is 8 9 individually solicited, whether classified as an individual annuity or group annuity. 10 11 Sec. 1116.002. RESCISSION PERIOD REQUIRED. An annuity 12 contract must: 13 (1) authorize the purchaser to rescind the contract 14 and return it to the issuer without surrender fees for at least 30 days after the date the contract is entered into; and 15 16 (2) provide for a refund to a purchaser who rescinds the contract during that period equal to the amount paid by the 17 purchaser under the contract. 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 19 20 to an annuity contract delivered or issued for delivery on or after 21 January 1, 2010. A contract delivered or issued for delivery before 22 January 1, 2010, is governed by the law in effect immediately before 23 the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect 24 for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
