## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the penalty for driving while intoxicated.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 49.04, Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<u>Subsection</u>] (c) <u>and</u>
- 8 (d) and Section 49.09, an offense under this section is a Class B
- 9 misdemeanor, with a minimum term of confinement of 72 hours.
- 10 <u>(d) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this</u>
- 11 section that an analysis of a specimen of the person's blood,
- 12 breath, or urine showed an alcohol concentration level of 0.15 or
- 13 more at the time the analysis was performed, the offense is a Class
- 14 A misdemeanor.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 22 committed before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
