5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 51.952, Education Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:

9	SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
10	amended by adding Section 51.9521 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 51.9521. STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE AT GENERAL ACADEMIC
12	TEACHING INSTITUTIONS. (a) In this section:
13	(1) "Health benefit plan" means any health benefit
14	plan regulated under the Insurance Code, including:

- 15 (A) an individual, group, or blanket health
- 16 insurance policy; or
- 17 (B) an evidence of coverage issued by a health
- 18 maintenance organization.
- 19 (2) "High deductible health plan" has the meaning
- assigned by Section 223, Internal Revenue Code of 1986. 20
- (3) "General academic teaching institution" and 21
- 22 "university system" have the meanings assigned by Section 61.003.
- (b) A general academic teaching institution shall offer or 23
- sponsor, directly or through the university system, if any, of 24

- 1 which the institution is a component, one or more health benefit
- 2 plans for the students of the institution. At least one health
- 3 benefit plan offered under this section must be a high deductible
- 4 health plan.
- 5 (c) The institution shall provide each student the option
- 6 to:
- 7 (1) enroll in a health benefit plan offered under this
- 8 section at the time of the student's registration; and
- 9 (2) pay the premium or other charges for coverage
- 10 under the plan in the same payment that includes the student's
- 11 <u>tuition</u> and fees.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 51.9521, Education Code, as added by
- 13 this Act, applies beginning with the 2010 fall semester.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
