5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 1101, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1101.3051 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1101.3051. ONLINE AND CORRESPONDENCE COURSES. An
8	accredited real estate or real estate inspection education program
9	may offer a course required to obtain a license under this chapter
10	or Chapter 1102 online or by correspondence if:
11	(1) the program is a domestic entity, as defined by
12	Section 1.002, Business Organizations Code;
13	(2) the program's principal office is located in this
14	<pre>state;</pre>
15	(3) the course that is offered online or by
16	correspondence is also offered with in-person instruction by the
17	program at a physical location in this state;
18	(4) the course:
19	(A) has learning objectives for each area of
20	instruction;
21	(B) is measured in clock hours of instruction;
22	(C) includes pre-assessments in each area of
23	instruction to determine the student's level of competence before
24	taking the course; and

1	(D) includes post-assessments to determine the
2	student's overall comprehension of the subject matter;
3	(5) the program requires students who are completing a
4	correspondence course to pass an examination administered by a
5	proctor who meets requirements adopted by the commission by rule;
6	(6) the program requires students who are completing
7	an online course to pass an examination that includes a method to
8	calculate the time for each question or time for each area of study;
9	(7) the program provides for an instructor approved by
10	the commission to be available by telephone or e-mail or online to
11	answer students' questions; and
12	(8) each of the program's instructors is approved by
13	the commission.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
