1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the interstate purchase of certain firearms.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 46.07, Penal Code, is amended to read as
1-11 follows:

1-12 Sec. 46.07. INTERSTATE PURCHASE. A resident of this state
1-13 may, if not otherwise precluded by law, purchase firearms,
1-14 ammunition, reloading components, or firearm accessories in
1-15 another state [~~contiguous states~~]. This authorization is enacted
1-16 in conformance with 18 U.S.C. Section 922(b)(3)(A) [~~Public Law~~
1-17 ~~90-618, 90th Congress~~].

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
