1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the powers and duties of the Bastrop County Water
1-11 Control and Improvement District No. 2.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 11001.007, Special District Local Laws
1-14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 11001.007. MONTHLY CHARGES. (a) The board by
1-16 resolution may impose a monthly charge in an amount not to exceed
1-17 \$15 [of five dollars] for each developed or undeveloped lot, tract,
1-18 or reserve in the district.

1-19 (a-1) The board may not increase the monthly charge for a
1-20 developed or undeveloped lot, tract, or reserve in the district by
1-21 more than \$3 in any calendar year. The board may grant an exemption
1-22 to an increase in the monthly charge to the owner of a lot, tract, or
1-23 reserve in the district who:

1-24 (1) is 65 years of age or older and who uses the lot,
1-25 tract, or reserve as a residence; or

1-26 (2) has been determined to have a disability by and has
1-27 written documentation of the disability from the United States
1-28 Social Security Administration or the United States Department of
1-29 Veterans Affairs.

1-30 (b) Money received from the monthly charge may [~~must~~] be
1-31 used only for:

1-32 (1) constructing, maintaining, or repairing public
1-33 streets or roadways in the district; or

1-34 (2) purchasing equipment necessary to maintain or
1-35 repair public streets or roadways in the district.

1-36 (c) Of the money received under Subsection (a) each fiscal
1-37 year:

1-38 (1) not more than 10 percent may be used for
1-39 administrative purposes; and

1-40 (2) not less [~~more~~] than 15 percent shall [~~may~~] be used
1-41 for road maintenance.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
