1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to a water rights permit issued to the Upper Guadalupe
1-9 River Authority.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 642, Acts of the 80th Legislature,
1-12 Regular Session, 2007, is amended by adding Section 1A to read as
1-13 follows:

1-14 Sec. 1A. To help facilitate the statewide and regional
1-15 goals of making efficient and responsible use of the state's water
1-16 resources, the Upper Guadalupe River Authority may contract to
1-17 provide any Kerr County entity, and may otherwise use in Kerr
1-18 County, water for municipal use under Permit No. 5394A, which was
1-19 issued to the Upper Guadalupe River Authority by the Texas Natural
1-20 Resource Conservation Commission, the predecessor agency to the
1-21 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. This section supersedes
1-22 Permit No. 5394A, and specifically Special Condition No. 5D.i of
1-23 the permit, to the extent of any conflict.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
