S.B. No. 1212

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT  
2 relating to granting limited state law enforcement authority to  
3 special agents of the Office of Inspector General of the United  
4 States Department of Veterans Affairs.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Article 2.122, Code of Criminal  
7 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

8 (a) The following named criminal investigators of the  
9 United States shall not be deemed peace officers, but shall have the  
10 powers of arrest, search and seizure as to felony offenses only  
11 under the laws of the State of Texas:

12 (1) Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of  
13 Investigation;

14 (2) Special Agents of the United States Secret  
15 Service;

16 (3) Special Agents of the United States Immigration  
17 and Customs Enforcement agency [~~Customs Service~~];

18 (4) Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,  
19 [~~and~~] Firearms and Explosives;

20 (5) Special Agents of the United States [~~Federal~~] Drug  
21 Enforcement Administration [~~Agency~~];

22 (6) Inspectors of the United States Postal Inspection  
23 Service;

24 (7) Special Agents of the Criminal Investigation

1 Division and Inspectors of the Internal Security Division of the  
2 Internal Revenue Service;

3 (8) Civilian Special Agents of the United States Naval  
4 Criminal Investigative Service;

5 (9) Marshals and Deputy Marshals of the United States  
6 Marshals Service;

7 (10) [~~Special Agents of the United States Immigration  
8 and Naturalization Service; and~~

9 [~~(11)~~] Special Agents of the United States Department  
10 of State, Bureau of Diplomatic Security; and

11 (11) Special Agents of the Office of Inspector General  
12 of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
