- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 2.122(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The following named criminal investigators of the
- 9 United States shall not be deemed peace officers, but shall have the
- 10 powers of arrest, search and seizure as to felony offenses only
- 11 under the laws of the State of Texas:
- 12 (1) Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of
- 13 Investigation;
- 14 (2) Special Agents of the United States Secret
- 15 Service;
- 16 (3) Special Agents of the United States Immigration
- 17 and Customs Enforcement Agency [Customs Service];
- 18 (4) Special Agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,
- 19 [and] Firearms and Explosives;
- 20 (5) Special Agents of the United States [Federal] Drug
- 21 Enforcement Administration [Agency];
- 22 (6) Inspectors of the United States Postal Inspection
- 23 Service;
- 24 (7) Special Agents of the Criminal Investigation

- 3 (8) Civilian Special Agents of the United States Naval
- 4 <u>Criminal</u> Investigative Service;

- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
