- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Business & Commerce Code, as
- 6 effective April 1, 2009, is amended by adding Chapter 106 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 CHAPTER 106. INCREASING AWARENESS OF NATIVE PLANT SPECIES
- 9 Sec. 106.101. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "plant nursery"
- 10 means a business that sells plants to the public. The term includes
- 11 a landscaping service.
- Sec. 106.102. REQUIREMENT. A plant nursery shall make
- 13 available to its customers a printed copy of the brochure developed
- 14 by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department under Section 12.0105,
- 15 Parks and Wildlife Code, that describes the benefits of native
- 16 plant species and the problems associated with invasive plant
- 17 species. The plant nursery may satisfy the requirement of this
- 18 section by posting in a conspicuous location accessible to the
- 19 nursery's customers a sign that contains the department's Internet
- 20 website address for the brochure.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Parks and Wildlife
- 22 Code, is amended by adding Section 12.0105 to read as follows:
- Sec. 12.0105. The department may develop and maintain on
- 24 the department's Internet website a brochure describing the

- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
