A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

_	AN ACT
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- 2 relating to a study regarding the Carrizo-Wilcox aquifer.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "commission" means the
- 5 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 6 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The commission shall conduct a study
- 7 regarding the impact on the entire Carrizo-Wilcox aquifer of rules
- 8 and plans adopted by groundwater conservation districts in whose
- 9 boundaries the aquifer is located and of determinations made by
- 10 groundwater conservation districts in connection with the joint
- 11 planning process relating to groundwater management areas in whose
- 12 boundaries the aquifer is located. In conducting the study, the
- 13 commission shall examine:
- 14 (1) whether the rules and plans adopted by each
- 15 groundwater conservation district:
- 16 (A) are based on sound scientific principles;
- 17 (B) adequately conserve and protect the aquifer
- 18 and ensure the achievement of the applicable desired future
- 19 condition for each part of the district; and
- (C) are likely to affect other groundwater
- 21 conservation districts or groundwater management areas;
- 22 (2) whether each district is enforcing substantial
- 23 compliance with its rules;
- 24 (3) whether the desired future conditions established

- 1 under Section 36.108, Water Code, in each groundwater management
- 2 area are reasonable and based on sound scientific principles, and
- 3 whether the rules adopted by each district are designed to achieve
- 4 the applicable desired future condition;
- 5 (4) other long-term impacts of the applicable rules
- 6 and plans on the aquifer, taking into consideration:
- 7 (A) projected population and agricultural,
- 8 municipal, and industrial demands for water from the aquifer;
- 9 (B) the effect of the demands described by
- 10 Paragraph (A) of this subdivision on the viability of the aquifer;
- 11 (C) the social and economic consequences of any
- 12 probable long-term impact on the aquifer; and
- 13 (D) other appropriate factors as determined by
- 14 commission rule; and
- 15 (5) whether the presence of contaminants in the
- 16 recharge area of the aquifer and the potential pollution of the
- 17 aquifer are issues that should be addressed and, if so, by whom.
- 18 (b) The Texas Water Development Board and the Bureau of
- 19 Economic Geology of The University of Texas at Austin shall assist
- 20 the commission in conducting the study under this section.
- 21 (c) The commission may contract with any appropriate person
- 22 to assist the commission in conducting the study under this
- 23 section.
- SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than December 31, 2012, the
- 25 commission shall report the results of the study conducted under
- 26 this Act to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of
- 27 the house of representatives, and the standing committees in the

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- 1 senate and the house of representatives that have primary
- 2 jurisdiction over natural resources. The report may include the
- 3 commission's recommendations for legislation to address any areas
- 4 of concern.
- 5 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION. This Act expires August 31, 2013.
- 6 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 7 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 8 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 9 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 10 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
