- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is

- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 10 adding Section 55.004 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 55.004. TEMPORARY LICENSE. (a) In this section,
- 12 "military" means the armed forces of the United States.
- 13 (b) A state agency that issues a license shall adopt rules
- 14 for the expedited issuance of a temporary license to an applicant
- 15 who:
- 16 (1) is serving on active duty as a member of the
- 17 military;
- 18 (2) was honorably discharged from active duty as a
- 19 member of the military not more than one year before the date of the
- 20 application; or
- 21 (3) is the spouse of a person who is serving on active
- 22 duty as a member of the military.
- (c) The state agency shall issue the temporary license under

- 1 (1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the
- 2 agency; and
- 3 (2) pays the required fees.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
