5	SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 55. <u>LICENSING OF</u> [ <del>RENEWAL OF LICENSE WHILE ON</del> ] MILITARY
8	MEMBER OR MILITARY SPOUSE [DUTY]
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is amended by
10	adding Section 55.004 to read as follows:
11	Sec. 55.004. TEMPORARY LICENSE. (a) In this section,
12	"military" means the armed forces of the United States.
13	(b) A state agency that issues a license shall adopt rules
14	for the expedited issuance of a temporary license to an applicant
15	who:
16	(1) is serving on active duty as a member of the
17	<pre>military;</pre>
18	(2) was honorably discharged from active duty as a
19	member of the military not more than one year before the date of the
20	application; or
21	(3) is the spouse of a person who is serving on active
22	duty as a member of the military.
23	(c) The state agency shall issue the temporary license under
24	this section to a qualified applicant who:

S.B. No. 1240 (1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the agency; and (2) pays the required fees.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
