BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is 1-9 1-10 1-11 1-12 amended to read as follows: CHAPTER 55. LICENSING OF [RENEWAL OF LICENSE WHILE ON] MILITARY 1-13 MEMBER OR MILITARY SPOUSE [DUTY] 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 SECTION 2. Chapter 55, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 55.004 to read as follows: 1-17 Sec. 55.004. TEMPORARY LICENSE. In this section, (a) "military" means the armed forces of the United States. 1-18 1-19 A state agency that issues a license shall adopt rules 1-20 1-21 the expedited issuance of a temporary license to an applicant for who: 1-22 (1)is serving on active duty as a member of the military; 1-23 1-24 (2) was honorably discharged from active duty member of the military not more than one year before the date of the 1-25 1-26 application; or 1-27 (3) is the spouse of a person who is serving on active duty as a member of the military.

(c) The state agency shall issue the temporary license under 1-28 1-29 this section to a qualified applicant who:
(1) submits an application on a form prescribed by the 1-30 1-31 1-32 agency; and pays the required fees. 1-33 This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-34 SECTION 3. a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-35 1-36 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
