- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.003(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if, during the voting period
- 8 [and within 100 feet of an outside door through which a voter may
- 9 enter the building in which a polling place is located], the
- 10 person[+
- 11 $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ loiters $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$ or
- [(2)] electioneers for or against any candidate,
- 13 measure, or political party:
- 14 (1) within 250 feet of an outside door through which a
- 15 voter may enter the building in which a polling place is located; or
- 16 (2) within 25 feet of any voter standing in line to
- 17 vote at a polling place.
- SECTION 2. Section 61.010(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person may not
- 21 wear a badge, insignia, emblem, or other similar communicative
- 22 device relating to a candidate, measure, or political party
- 23 appearing on the ballot, or to the conduct of the election, in the
- 24 polling place or within the area within which electioneering is

- 1 prohibited [100 feet of any outside door through which a voter may
- 2 enter the building in which the polling place is located].
- 3 SECTION 3. Sections 62.013(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (a) An election officer commits an offense if the officer
- 6 knowingly posts at a polling place, including the area within which
- 7 <u>electioneering is prohibited</u> [100 feet of an outside door through
- 8 which a voter may enter the building in which the polling place is
- 9 located], a sign, card, poster, or other similar material that:
- 10 (1) is not authorized or required by law; or
- 11 (2) is in a form or contains information that is not
- 12 authorized or required by law.
- 13 (b) A person other than an election officer commits an
- 14 offense if the person posts a sign, card, poster, or other similar
- 15 material at a polling place, including the $[\frac{100-foot}{}]$ area within
- 16 which electioneering is prohibited [described by Subsection (a)].
- SECTION 4. Section 85.036(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (a) During the time an early voting polling place is open
- 20 for the conduct of early voting, a person may not electioneer for or
- 21 against any candidate, measure, or political party:
- 22 (1) in or within 250 $[\frac{100}{100}]$ feet of an outside door
- 23 through which a voter may enter the building or structure in which
- 24 the early voting polling place is located; or
- 25 (2) within 25 feet of any voter standing in line to
- 26 vote at a polling place.
- 27 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect when the election was ordered, and the
- 4 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
