BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 605, Occupations Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 605.2515 to read as follows: 7 8 Sec. 605.2515. ADDITIONAL LICENSE: DEVICE MANUFACTURER. A person licensed to practice orthotics or prosthetics who measures, 9 10 designs, fabricates, fits, assembles, adjusts, or services an orthosis or a prosthesis under an order from a licensed physician, 11 chiropractor, or podiatrist for a specific patient is exempt from 12 licensing as a device manufacturer under Subchapter L, Chapter 431, 13 Health and Safety Code. A person licensed to practice orthotics or 14 prosthetics who fabricates or assembles an orthosis or a prosthesis 15 without an order from a licensed physician, chiropractor, or 16 17 podiatrist for a specific patient is required to be licensed as a device manufacturer under Subchapter L, Chapter 431, Health and 18 Safety Code. 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22

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Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
