A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to authorization for school districts to provide mentors
- 3 for teachers assigned to a new subject or grade level.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 21.458, Education Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Each school district may assign a mentor teacher to each
- 8 classroom teacher who has less than two years of teaching
- 9 experience in the subject or grade level to which the teacher is
- 10 assigned. A teacher assigned as a mentor must:
- 11 (1) teach in the same school;
- 12 (2) to the extent practicable, teach the same subject
- 13 or grade level, as applicable; and
- 14 (3) meet the qualifications prescribed by
- 15 commissioner rules adopted under Subsection (b).
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
