- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.404, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1701.404. CERTIFICATION OF OFFICERS FOR MENTAL HEALTH
- 8 ASSIGNMENTS. (a) The commission by rule may establish minimum
- 9 requirements for the training, testing, and certification of
- 10 special officers for offenders with mental impairments.
- 11 (b) The commission may certify a sheriff, sheriff's deputy,
- 12 constable, [or] other peace officer, county jailer, or [a] justice
- 13 of the peace $[\tau]$ as a special officer for offenders with mental
- 14 impairments if the person [officer]:
- 15 (1) completes a training course in emergency first aid
- 16 and lifesaving techniques approved by the commission;
- 17 (2) completes a training course administered by the
- 18 commission on mental health issues and offenders with mental
- 19 impairments; and
- 20 (3) passes an examination administered by the
- 21 commission that is designed to test the person's [officer's]:
- (A) knowledge and recognition of the
- 23 characteristics and symptoms of mental illness, mental
- 24 retardation, and mental disabilities; and

- 1 (B) knowledge of mental health crisis
- 2 intervention strategies for people with mental impairments.
- 3 (c) The commission may issue a professional achievement or
- 4 proficiency certificate to an officer, county jailer, or justice of
- 5 the peace who meets the requirements of Subsection (b).
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer
- 7 Standards and Education may certify a county jailer as a special
- 8 officer for offenders with mental impairments and may issue a
- 9 certificate to the county jailer if the county jailer meets the
- 10 requirements of Subsection (b), Section 1701.404, Occupations
- 11 Code, as amended by this Act, regardless of whether the county
- 12 jailer completed the required training and passed the examination
- 13 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 (b) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and
- 15 Education may issue a certificate under Subsection (c), Section
- 16 1701.404, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, to a justice of
- 17 the peace who is certified as a special officer for offenders with
- 18 mental impairments regardless of whether the justice of the peace
- 19 was certified before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
