Section 573.001, Local Government Code, as effective April 1, 2009, is amended to read as follows: 1-13 Sec. 573.001. COUNTY OR DISTRICT SUBJECT TO CHAPTER. This 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 chapter applies only to: a county with a population of 2.8 million or more; (1)1-17 a district or authority created under Section 59, (2) Article XVI, Texas Constitution, that: 1-18 1-19 (A) has boundaries coterminous with a county described by Subdivision (1); and 1-20 1-21 (B) is authorized to provide stormwater drainage 1-22 and flood control facilities; [or] 1-23 (3) a county with a population of more than 1.3 million 1-24 for which the primary source of drinking water is an underground 1**-**25 1**-**26 aquifer; or (4)a county with a population of 800,000 or more that 1-27 contains a portion of the Edwards Aquifer. 1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-29 1-30 1-31 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
