- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) An agency that employs one or more [at least two] peace
- 9 officers shall designate a firearms proficiency officer and require
- 10 each peace officer the agency employs to demonstrate weapons
- 11 proficiency to the firearms proficiency officer at least annually.
- 12 The agency shall maintain records of the weapons proficiency of the
- 13 agency's peace officers.
- 14 SECTION 2. A law enforcement agency affected by the change
- 15 in law made by this Act shall designate a firearms proficiency
- 16 officer not later than March 1, 2010. For purposes of this section,
- 17 a state or local governmental entity that employs one or more peace
- 18 officers is a law enforcement agency.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
