4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.076 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1001.076. MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM FOR VETERANS. (a) In
8	this section, "veteran" means a person who:
9	(1) has served in:
10	(A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or
11	marine corps of the United States;

- 12 (B) the state military forces as defined by
- 13 Section 431.001, Government Code; or
- 14 (C) an auxiliary service of one of those branches
- 15 of the armed forces; and
- 16 (2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of
- 17 the service in which the person served.
- (b) The department shall develop a mental health
- 19 <u>intervention program for veterans</u>. The program must provide for
- 20 peer-to-peer counseling.
- 21 <u>(c) The department shall solicit and train volunteers to</u>
- 22 provide the peer-to-peer counseling.
- 23 SECTION 2. The Department of State Health Services shall
- 24 develop the mental health intervention program for veterans as

- 1 required by Section 1001.076, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 2 this Act, not later than January 1, 2010.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
