1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the disposition of surplus data processing equipment of
1-9 a university system or an institution or agency of higher
1-10 education.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 2175.304, Government Code, is amended by
1-13 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

1-14 (e) Notwithstanding Subsections (b) and (c), a university
1-15 system or institution or agency of higher education included within
1-16 the definition of "state agency" under Section 2151.002 may donate
1-17 data processing equipment that is surplus property to a public or
1-18 private hospital located in a rural county. For purposes of this
1-19 subsection, "rural county" has the meaning assigned by Section
1-20 487.301.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
