## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorization for an exemption from tuition and fees
- 3 charged by a junior college district for employees of the district
- 4 and for state reimbursement of the district's revenue loss from the
- 5 exemption.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 130.0851 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 130.0851. TUITION EXEMPTION FOR DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.
- 10 (a) The governing board of a junior college district may exempt a
- 11 district employee who enrolls in courses offered by the district
- 12 from the payment of all or part of the tuition or fees charged to a
- 13 student at a junior college by the district.
- 14 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 15 include in the formulas established under Section 61.059 funding in
- 16 amounts sufficient to cover a junior college district's revenue
- 17 loss from a tuition or fee exemption the district grants under
- 18 Subsection (a).
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
