1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to authorization for an exemption from tuition and fees
1-11 charged by a junior college district for employees of the district.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
1-14 amended by adding Section 130.0851 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 130.0851. TUITION EXEMPTION FOR DISTRICT EMPLOYEES.
1-16 The governing board of a junior college district may exempt a
1-17 district employee who enrolls in courses offered by the district
1-18 from the payment of all or part of the tuition or fees charged to a
1-19 student at a junior college by the district.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
