- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 681.003(e), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) If a first application for a disabled parking placard
- 8 under this section is made by or on behalf of a person with a
- 9 mobility problem caused by:
- 10 (1) a disorder of the foot, the notarized written
- 11 statement or written prescription required by Subsection (c) may be
- 12 issued by a person licensed to practice podiatry in this state or a
- 13 state adjacent to this state; or
- 14 (2) an impairment of vision, the notarized written
- 15 statement or written prescription required by Subsection (c) may be
- 16 issued by a person licensed to practice optometry or therapeutic
- 17 optometry in this state or a state adjacent to this state.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 19 an application for a disabled parking placard submitted on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 22 date the application is submitted, and the former law is continued
- 23 in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
