A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to notification of an applicant for admission to a general 3 academic teaching institution regarding the availability of degree 4 programs in the applicant's preferred major field of study offered 5 by other institutions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter S, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
amended by adding Section 51.7635 to read as follows:

Sec. 51.7635. NOTIFICATION REGARDING DEGREE PROGRAMS 9 OFFERED BY OTHER INSTITUTIONS IN APPLICANT'S PREFERRED MAJOR FIELD. 10 (a) The board by rule shall require that each applicant for 11 admission to a general academic teaching institution who designates 12 on the applicant's ApplyTexas online admission application form or 13 other electronic application form applicable to all general 14 15 academic teaching institutions one or more choices or preferences for the applicant's major field of study must promptly be 16 17 redirected by the application website to a notification regarding the availability of degree programs in that field of study offered 18 by general academic teaching institutions. 19

20 <u>(b) The notification required by Subsection (a) must</u> 21 <u>include a list of those general academic teaching institutions</u> 22 <u>offering comparable degree programs in the applicant's designated</u> 23 <u>field of study, and must provide the following information, or</u> 24 <u>electronic links to the following information, for each</u>

1 institution: 2 (1) the institution's location and distance from the applicant's home zip code; 3 4 (2) a description of the programs offered by the institution in the applicant's designated major field of study; 5 6 (3) graduation and retention rate information for the 7 institution; and 8 (4) any other information the board considers 9 appropriate to assist the applicant in selecting among institutions. 10 11 (c) In addition to providing the notification required by Subsection (a), if a general academic teaching institution denies 12 13 admission to any applicant who designated one or more choices or preferences for the applicant's major field of study on the 14 15 applicant's admission application form described by Subsection 16 (a), the institution shall include in its notice of denial a link to detailed information available on the application website 17 18 regarding the availability of degree programs in that field of study offered by other general academic teaching institutions. 19 SECTION 2. Section 51.7635, Education Code, as added by 20

21 this Act, applies beginning with applicants for admission to a 22 general academic teaching institution for the 2011-2012 academic 23 year.

SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.7635, Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may adopt the

1 initial rules in the manner provided by law for emergency rules.

2 SECTION 4. This Act does not make an appropriation. A 3 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program, 4 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental 5 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the 6 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the 7 provision.

8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
