A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to notification of an applicant for admission to a general

3 academic teaching institution regarding the availability of degree

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6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Subchapter S, Chapter 51, Education Code, is

8 amended by adding Section 51.7635 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 51.7635. NOTIFICATION REGARDING DEGREE PROGRAMS

10 OFFERED BY OTHER INSTITUTIONS IN APPLICANT'S PREFERRED MAJOR FIELD.

11 (a) Each applicant for admission to a general academic teaching

12 institution who designates on the applicant's online common

admission application form or other electronic application form

applicable to all general academic teaching institutions one or

15 more choices or preferences for the applicant's major field of

16 study must promptly be redirected by the application website to a

17 notification regarding the availability of degree programs in that

18 field of study offered by general academic teaching institutions.

19 <u>(b) The notification required by Subsection (a) must</u>

20 <u>include a list of those general academic teaching institutions</u>

21 offering comparable degree programs in the applicant's designated

22 field of study, and must provide the following information, or

23 electronic links to the following information, for each

24 institution:

- 1 (1) the institution's location and distance from the
- 2 applicant's home zip code;
- 3 (2) a description of the programs offered by the
- 4 institution in the applicant's designated major field of study;
- 5 (3) graduation and retention rate information for the
- 6 institution; and
- 7 (4) any other information the board considers
- 8 appropriate to assist the applicant in selecting among
- 9 institutions.
- 10 (c) In addition to providing the notification required by
- 11 Subsection (a), if a general academic teaching institution denies
- 12 admission to any applicant who designated one or more choices or
- 13 preferences for the applicant's major field of study on a timely and
- 14 complete application form described by Subsection (a), the
- 15 institution shall include in its notice of denial a link to detailed
- 16 <u>information available on the application website regarding the</u>
- 17 availability of degree programs in that field of study offered by
- 18 other general academic teaching institutions.
- 19 (d) The provision and receipt of information under this
- 20 section does not guarantee the availability of a degree program or
- 21 admission to a degree program and does not constitute a waiver of

- 23 (e) The board, in consultation with the appropriate
- 24 advisory committees for common application forms, shall adopt rules
- 25 as necessary for the administration of this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 51.7635, Education Code, as added by

- 1 general academic teaching institution for the 2011-2012 academic

- 3 SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
- 4 shall adopt the rules required by Section 51.7635, Education Code,
- 5 as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 6 effect. For that purpose, the coordinating board may adopt the
- 7 initial rules in the manner provided by law for emergency rules.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act does not make an appropriation. A
- 9 provision in this Act that creates a new governmental program,
- 10 creates a new entitlement, or imposes a new duty on a governmental
- 11 entity is not mandatory during a fiscal period for which the
- 12 legislature has not made a specific appropriation to implement the
- 13 provision.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
